Cleaning is \$390 - an increase over last year's budget

Motion to accept request by Jennie, Catherine
seconded - unanimous

LIBRARY

Request \$17,874

Electric Line was cut by Board of Selectmen
based on what was spent last year (50 per month)
Pam disagrees with \$420 - amount, bill is \$36
per month.

Jennie asks if gross basis money 3000 had
been spent.

Request is for \$17,874 and only \$7,600 has been
spent to date.

Ed suggests that restrooms be cut to \$450 -

LIBRARY continued.

Heating request is up by \$1350 -

Media \$1500 - Reduced by Board of Selectmen Ed
WANTS TO leave it at \$1500

Phone/fax \$1,850

PD \$375 -

Supplies \$300 - Leave as is

Wages 7,606 went up to \$1400

Ed wants to put back to \$12,272

Shoveling will come out of general government buildings
