No exact dollar amount known as yet for dispatch
cost of cf card + radio \$6091

Retirement can't be changed \$4,2125

Fair amount negotiable went down

attorney

2 positions part time patrol + secretary

Training \$8000 - 10,000

Discussion regarding insurance

There is enough money in the Capitol Reserve to
buy a new police cruiser this year $(214,563) \times 53.175$
