Burn Pile at Pine Grove – No news.

Seasonal Workers – Hired 2 young men who have started working and so far seem to be doing a pretty good job. Ed took the leaf blowers and trimmers to D&B because none of them would start.

Rachel Prosser – No response regarding the letter sent about a bleeding heart plant and no check sent to the town for cornerstones.

New Business

Allison Gilliland – Aime was contacted by Allison Gilliland because she wants a sign placed at her mother's property (Joyce Truman) for the family cemetery that's there. There was some discussion regarding the Sleeper Family Cemetery Plot there and what may have happened with the headstones. It was decided that Aime will let her know that Allison would need her mother's permission to put a sign up there, not the Cemetery Trustees, as it's not a town maintained cemetery.

Sexton Report

There were no burials or lots sold. Cindy reported that the Gagnons had asked when their cornerstones would be installed and Ed said Laconia Monument was waiting for more to be needed in town before fulfilling the order. Now that there have been, they should all be done soon.
