How Do I Arrange for Chore Corps?



Call our toll free number: 1-877-711-7787. Staff will talk with you about your needs, priorities, and resources. We will try to match you with a volunteer from your area, who has the appropriate skills.

If available, a volunteer will call you and arrange to come out and assess the situation, measure it up if needed, or do the work then.

Home-owners must pay for materials - - we have no funding for that.

Some requests may be beyond the scope of Chore Corps, including situations requiring licensed contractors. We do not offer ongoing maintenance services such as plowing or lawn mowing.

Chore Corps is not an emergency service. We need about one week notice to contact volunteers and to give them time to contact you.
